

The Doochin Family Scholarship was established to support formerly incarcerated individuals attending Nashville State. This scholarship will provide support to a full or part-time student pursuing an Associate Degree at Nashville State. Each recipient is awarded a maximum of \$2,686.00 each semester. Funds can be used to assist with tuition, textbooks, supplies, or fees. Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

Priority is given to students who are current enrollees with a goal of degree completion. Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

To qualify, please submit your NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form through your myNSCC. You must complete this form each year by May 31st. We recommend that you submit your form early.



This scholarship is awarded to qualified applicants based on the following criteria:

- Applicants must be formerly incarcerated individuals.
- Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Applicants must be pursuing an AA, AS, or AAS Degree.
- Applicants must be in good academic standing and meet satisfactory academic progress standards, as measured for federal Title IV Programs.

For incarcerated applicants, all requested materials should be submitted to a THEC Navigator or THEI Coordinator. The THEC Navigator and THEI will forward the application to Nashville State Community College Foundation.

For formerly incarcerated applicants, all requested materials should be submitted to the NSCC Foundation office. Materials should be directed to the Ryan Parker, and emailed to ryan.parker@nsc.edu. Please include The Doochin Family Scholarship application in the subject line.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
