Please note that the completion of a community-college curriculum does not guarantee acceptance into a baccalaureate nursing program. Nursing is a highly competitive major, and only the most highly qualified students are admitted. However, 16 seats are reserved for Nashville State graduates of this program (as written) who earn a GPA of 3.0 in each fall BSN class at Belmont University. The specific requirements for admission to university nursing programs may be found in the catalogs of the various universities. Students interested in BSN nursing programs other than Belmont University should declare the Transfer BSN Pathway.

This sequence can be followed by students who begin in the fall semester. Prerequisites may apply to specific courses; it is the student's responsibility to determine if prerequisites have been met. Additional semesters will be required if prerequisite courses must be completed. Prior to registering each semester, the student is expected to consult with his/her advisor.

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
