

#### Advising for Learning Support Math:

The following groups of students are not required to take a co-requisite math lab experience and should register for any section of entry level college level math course they need with no additional lab.

1. Students with a 19 or higher on the math portion of the ACT within the past 5 years\*
2. Students with a grade of 250 or higher on Next Generation Accuplacer (November 2018 and later).
3. Students who completed all 5 learning support modules at NSCC prior to fall 2015.
4. Students who completed a high school SAILS Algebra program regardless of ACT.
5. Student who completed SAILS Statistics may enroll in MATH 1530 without MATH 0835 or in MATH 1010 without MATH 0825.

New Students who enter with an ACT math score of 18 or below and have not completed SAILS Algebra in high school ARE required to take a co-requisite math lab experience. SAILS Statistics completers who enroll in MATH 1630 as their first college-level math course will be required to take MATH 0845 as a co-requisite.

Once you have determined that a student is required to take a support lab, the following table indicates in which lab they should co-register: <b>Math Course (3 credits &amp; 3 contact hours)</b>	<b>Lab Co-Requisite (1 credit and 2 contact hours)</b>
MATH 1010: Math for General Studies	MATH 0825
MATH 1530: Introductory Statistics	MATH 0835
MATH 1630: Finite Math	MATH 0845

#### Programs that do not require mathematics at the college-level:

Certain technical certificate programs do not require that students take college-level math but they do require that students achieve learning support competency in math. Students who have declared such a technical certificate may enroll in MATH 0810, which is a stand-alone class. Student enrollment in MATH 0810 will require the permission of the Academic Dean of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics.
