

Enable Text Message Notifications

1. Go to [the D2L homepage](#), where your courses are displayed.
2. Select the box that has your name and profile picture, in the upper right hand corner.
3. From the drop down menu, select **Notifications**.




4. Under **Contact Methods**, select **Register Your Mobile**.




Customize Notifications
