

FINISH LINE SCHOLARSHIP

The Finish Line Scholarship is made possible through the generous support of Nashville State faculty and staff, local businesses and corporations, private foundations, individual supporters, and members of the Nashville State Foundation Board of Trustees. Created to expand access to higher education, this scholarship provides flexible financial support for students in their last semester at Nashville State Community College.

Recipients may be awarded up to \$1,500 in the spring semester of each academic year, depending on available funding.

To be considered, you must submit the NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form via your myNSCC portal by June 30th each year. Early submission is strongly encouraged.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must have a GPA of 2.0.
- Must be a have completed at least 75% of more toward completion of an Associate Degree or Technical Certificate.
- Award must no adversely affect the recipient's financial aid.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
