Important Graduation Ceremony Information

- Rehearsal is mandatory.
- Arrive at rehearsal by 1:45 pm. Rehearsal will begin at 2:00 pm SHARP!
- Bring your Name Card (Call Card) to rehearsal AND the ceremony.
- Bring your Cap and Gown to the ceremony ONLY along with your Call Card.
- Graduates can only wear college-approved ceremonial medals, pins, honors
 cords, and stoles with their cap and gown. Approved stoles include SGA,
 PTK, NSLS, Kappa Beta Delta, Honors College, and veteran's stoles/cords.
 Pins-Nursing honors pins, and SGA and honors college medallions. The
 hijabs are approved head coverings with the caps secured to them.
- No other adornments or embellishments such as pins, stoles, cords, ribbons, scarves, flowers, medallions, patches, or stitchery, among others, may be worn. If any alteration occurs to the gown you will be provided another to wear the day of commencement.
- Wear dark-colored pants, skirts, and shoes. NO BLUE JEANS, TENNIS SHOES, OR FLIP-FLOPS. Be sure to wear comfortable shoes.
- All electronic devices should be silenced at both the rehearsal and the ceremony. Please tell your guests.
- Please instruct your guests not to bring or use noisemakers of any type during the ceremony. Also, balloons will not be allowed in Allen Arena.
- Due to heavy traffic, you must plan your schedule accordingly and arrive early to allow time to line up.
- Line-Up for the Graduation Ceremony is at 5:00 pm. Graduates arriving late, after the processional has started, will be directed to sit in the last row(s) of the commencement area during the ceremony. Even if graduates have been to rehearsal, late arrivals will not be allowed to disrupt the ceremony by cutting into line or seating. Late arrivals will still have their names called to walk across the stage and graduation photos made.
- It is required that you attend the entire ceremony. Once you are seated, you will not be able to leave until the ceremony is over.
- Only Nashville State graduates are allowed on the arena floor. All guests of graduates must be seated in the stands.

Cap and Gown Etiquette

How should my cap be worn?

The cap should be worn so that the Mortarboard is level. It should not be tilted to the back or side of the head. The crown should be approximately one inch above the eyebrow.

How do I tell the front from the back of the cap?

The front of the cap is indicated on the inside of the crown.

Should the cap be removed anytime during the graduation ceremony? Your cap should not be removed during the graduation ceremony.

Can I decorate my Mortarboard?

You can decorate the top of your Mortarboard only. No decorations may hang off the edge, sides, or around the crown of the Mortarboard.

How do I take care of my gown?

The gown should be removed immediately from the package and placed on a hanger.

What can I wear with my gown?

Graduates can only wear college-approved ceremonial medals, pins, honors cords and stoles with their cap and gown. Approved stoles include, SGA, PTK, NSLS, Kappa Beta Delta, Honors College, and veteran's stoles/cords. Pins-Nursing, honors pins, and SGA and honors college medallions. The hijabs are approved head coverings with the caps secured to them.

No other adornments or embellishments such as pins, stoles, cords, ribbons, scarves, flowers, medallions, patches, or stitchery, among others, may be worn. If any alteration occurs to the gown you will be provided another to wear the day of commencement.

The gown seemed wrinkled when I took it out of the package, should I send it to the cleaners?

The gown should not be washed or dry-cleaned. It may be pressed with a cool iron or steamed.

What should I wear underneath the gown?

You should wear lightweight, comfortable clothing.

How do I wear the tassel?

Tassels are worn over the right temple at the beginning of the ceremony. After receiving your diploma, but before your photograph is taken, move the tassel to your left temple.



Photography and Videotaping Permission

By participating in and attending the Graduation Commencement ceremonies, you and your guests agree to be videotaped, audio recorded, and photographed by the office of Communications and Marketing and its designees. You and your guests give permission and absolute right to Nashville State Community College and its employees to use/publish the images and audio from graduation to promote Nashville State Community College, its students, and its programs. You waive the right to view these images and release Nashville State from any liability associated with the use of said images and audio.

You agree that neither you nor any agent representing you will receive any monetary compensation or fee for use of said images and audio now or anytime in the future.

Commencement Day Photographs

Each graduate should expect to be photographed three times during the Nashville State Community College Commencement Ceremony.

- 1. First photo is taken before you go across the stage
- 2. Second photo is taken as you shake hands with Commencement Guest Speaker and Nashville State President on stage.
- 3. Third photo is taken off stage just before returning to your seat


For best results, remember to pull back your tassel (as well as any long hair) from your face. Footprints on the floor will mark the place for you to stand for the first and third photo. After the person in front of you is finished, simply step onto these footprints, pause briefly, and smile at the photographer. There is no need to pause or look at the photographer for the second photo.

FROM NORTH OF NASHVILLE ON I-65 OR I-24

Take I-65 to I-40 West to I-440 East. Take Exit 3 (21st Ave./Hillsboro Pike). When the off-ramp splits, follow the signs to Hillsboro Pike. Once you are on Hillsboro Pike, turn left at the third stoplight (Woodmont Blvd.) See FINAL DIRECTIONS below.

FROM SOUTH OF NASHVILLE ON I-65

Take I-440 West. Take Exit 3 (21st Ave./Hillsboro Pk). When the off-ramp splits, follow the signs to Hillsboro Pike. Once you are on Hillsboro Pike, turn left at the third stoplight (Woodmont Blvd.)

See FINAL DIRECTIONS below.

FROM EAST OF NASHVILLE ON I-40

Take I-24 East to I-440 West. Take Exit 3 (21st Ave./Hillsboro Pk). When the off-ramp splits, follow the signs to Hillsboro Pike. Once you are on Hillsboro Pike, turn left at the third stoplight (Woodmont Blvd.) See FINAL DIRECTIONS below.

FROM WEST OF NASHVILLE ON I-40

Take I-440 East. Take Exit 3 (21st Ave./Hillsboro Pk). When the off-ramp splits, follow the signs until you are on Hillsboro Pike. Turn left at the third stoplight (Woodmont Blvd.) See FINAL DIRECTIONS below.

FINAL DIRECTIONS FOR ALLEN ARENA

At the second stoplight, turn right onto Granny White Pike. Go approximately two blocks and the campus will be on your right.
